McCoy served as the President of the Industrial Design Society of America from 1983 to 1984. She was also honored to be the 1982 IBM Fellow of the International Design Conference at Aspen. McCoy recently juried the 1984 United States Presidential Design Awards. McCoy studied industrial design at Michigan State University.
