James Lamb Exhibition

1. The James Lamb exhibition is comprised of a series of 24 paintings, two diagramatics, and twenty four storyboards. The paintings range in years from 1986-1989. The linear or running feet of the exhibition is 93 feet (frame to frame). The exhibition will occupy a gallery space of 3,100 square feet in Gallery 400 at the University of Illinois at Chicago, which is the first destination on the tour.

2. The participation fee is \$2,500, plus incoming shipping, insurance, and handling costs. Upon signing a participation contract with Chaplin Fine Arts, a deposit of \$625.00 (1/4 of the fee) will be requested insuring participating museums or galleries imprint in a brochure about the artist, including the travelling dates of the exhibition. The deadline for participation scheduling is February 1990.

3. The exhibition rental period is six weeks with a five week period allowed in between bookings for crating, shipping and installation. A temporary schedule is enclosed.

4. All of the paintings are framed. Many of which are painted by the artist. Each painting is accompanied by an 8" x 10" story board (a copy of an example is enclosed), except for the two which are accompanied by the diagramatics (a slide of which may be viewed in the accompanying slide sleeve). Each museum or gallery is responsible to supply their own glass to cover the story boards.
