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Designing Egos by Eun Hyung Kim

In Eun Hyung Kim's dense floor to ceiling wall drawings, drawing covered paper objects and animated video, myriad black and and white cartoon scenes collide. Simplified figures, often reduced to a head or face, populate allegorical tableaus of tumult, connection, confrontation, and fantasy.

John's Luv by Andy Moore

Alternately fiction, diary, mise-en-scene and metanarrative, *John's Luv* is a nearly 1,000 page handwritten and painted book, complete with 4 by 11 foot foldout painting. Begun in 2003, this massive undertaking pursues answers to Moore's unremitting ambiguities and doubts relative to the questions of community, God, love and daily life.

What Manner of Person Art Thou? by Erin Cosgrove

Structured on the seven deadly sins and inspired by the 11th century Bayeaux Tapestry, *What Manner of Person Art Thou?* is a 65-minute animated video that relates the twisted tale of two anachronistic believers who dispense violent justice on those they deem to be evildoers. It darkly allegorizes the hazards of morality and the corruption of modern life.
