In & Out is a collaborative project between Rirkrit Tiravanija, The Resource Center, and The School of Art and Design at The University of Illinois at Chicago. Throughout this project, Gallery 400 will serve as a recycling center of useful goods and materials*, acting as a site for exchange. **Gallery 400 welcomes the community to contribute and remove materials.** The physical objective is to create a cycle by which the Gallery opens containing only empty bins, and returns to its original state at the closing of the project. The conceptual objective is to lay the groundwork for an ongoing current of exchange between the art community, the university, and the larger community.
